Comment: pure lymp, new lymph, lymph that is aroma pouring violet in the glass, untouched, virgin, clothed with a perfume that offers chlorophyll sweetest olfactory frequencies of mixed berries and flower pollens. Fragrance and floral fruitiness apices that very rarely can be encountered thus purely emitted by edible substances of such a stupendous purple. A perfume wreath in which strawberry and raspberry – at maximum peak of effusive mellowness – marry the fragrance strength of a geranium and a rose whose just opened petal is still fleshy turgid. A taste that has no tips but just harmonic pulpiness, now sapid, then vivid, of originating grapes: fruits of absolute concentration and vigour, of exceptional and sumptuous sensorial and compositional quality: One of the wines with best aroma in one of the consistent, balanced and integral versions ever. The person that will experiment such a wine will keep the memory of this diadem of fragrance as apex of how nature con radiate in such ethereal and profound aroma.
